#### **1. Preliminary Events**

As is customary, much attention was focused on the list of Open Issues. A few additional modifications, then, were made throughout the document. At the conclusion of this discussion, **Bas Revet** offered to conduct one additional editorial pass through the document to ensure that all styles and customs had been observed. He will alert the **secretary** when this process is complete so that a seven-day letter ballot can be conducted among members of WG-06. No vote was taken during the teleconference. If the ballot is successful, the secretary will issue the document for **Public Comment**.
