- 1.2. Antitrust and patent rules were reviewed.

2. DICOM Conformance Statement Template (Supplement 209)

WG 31 members met with WG 15 members to present and receive feedback on the latest proposed new template for DICOM conformance statements (DCS).

Antje Schroeder presented the overview (purpose) & proposed DCS template structure (Supplement 209 draft). Herve Hoehn assisted with presenting the Security section of the DCS template.

WG 15 feedback during the discussion:

- Overview, Query/Retrieve: Request to indicate support for hierarchical vs relational
- SCU of Modality Worklist, Table 5.2-1, Display on UI column: Include a code to indicate the displayed value is not the exact return value
- SCP of Storage, Table 5.2-10: Request to remove. An application's internal storage method is not relevant to DICOM inter-operability. Transcoding of Transfer Syntaxes covers the inter-operability aspects of internal storage.

- Figure 7.1-1, Real World activity, Cross AE interaction: Request to provide diagram content guidance, for example, intent of the blue outline.
- Appendix A IODs: Within modules in tables, request to recommend attributes be in tag order for ease of comparison
