

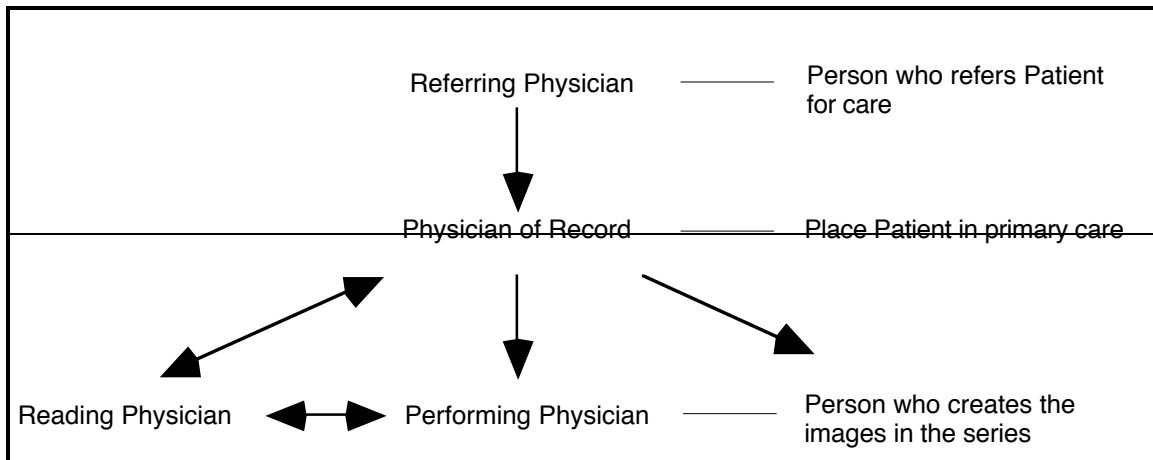

C.7.2.1.1.1 Referring Physician, Physician of Record, Physician Reading Study

Note:—The model used for application of attributes related to different functions of Physicians involved in the care **of a patient** is **as follows:** shown in Figure C.7-1. The figure shows some of the relationships and information flows between physician roles that might be present in some healthcare business models.



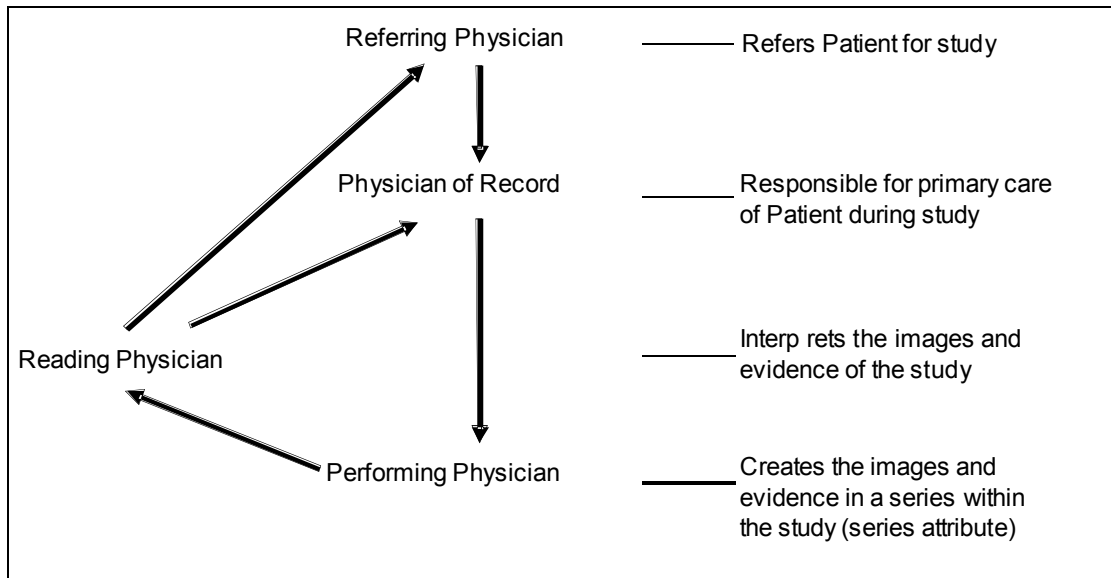


Figure C.7-1 Physician Roles and Relationships
