Rationale for Correction	
As of CP 148 clarifies that Interpretation Status ID is an Enumerated Value not Defined Term, yet it is used in PS 3.5 definition of Defined Terms as an example. Use Interpretation Type ID in the example instead.

Correction Wording:	

Note: Interpretation **Status Type** ID (4008, ~~02100212~~) is an example of a Data Element having Defined Terms. It is defined to have a Value that may be one of the set of standard Values; ~~"CREATED," "RECORDED," "TRANSCRIBED," or "APPROVED"~~ **"REPORT"** or **"AMENDMENT"** (see PS 3.3). Because this Data Element has Defined Terms, other Interpretation **Status Type** IDs may be defined by the implementor.
