<p>Rationale for Correction</p> <p>The attribute (0008,1080) is variously named Admitting Diagnoses Description (plural) or Admitting Diagnosis Description (singular). In the dictionary it has a VM of 1-n consistent with its description in the Patient Study Module and the plural name is used.</p> <p>Additionally, in the Visit Admission Module (but not the Patient Study Module) there is an attribute (0008,1084) Admitting Diagnosis Code Sequence (singular) that may have more than one item.</p> <p>Accordingly it is proposed that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. for both attributes "Diagnoses" (plural) rather than "Diagnosis" (singular) be used in the name; this has no impact on encoded objects, just on the documentation 2. the (0008,1084) code sequence attribute be added as an optional attribute to the Patient Study Module to allow a code rather than text description to be sent
