<p>Rationale for Correction</p> <p>When an MPPS N-SET Request message is received containing a status of 'DISCONTINUED' the SCP does not know the reason for the termination of the procedure. <del>Possible reasons include: the device has malfunctioned; the procedure has been interrupted so that a different procedure can be done; the procedure is being canceled.</del> It is proposed that an optional attribute be added to the Performed Procedure Step Information Module so that this information can be communicated. <u>Following is a list reasons for termination of a procedure step:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <u>Doctor cancelled</u></li> <li>2. <u>Incorrect exam</u></li> <li>3. <u>Patient allergic to media/contrast</u></li> <li>4. <u>Patient expired</u></li> <li>5. <u>Patient refused</u></li> <li>6. <u>Patient prep incomplete</u></li> <li>7. <u>Patient could not withstand procedure</u></li> <li>8. <u>Miscellaneous</u></li> </ol>
