Administrative Items

- The virtual teleconference was called to order and a quorum was present.
- DICOM antitrust and patent guidelines were reviewed.
- The agenda was reviewed and approved.

- The minutes from the WG-02/WG-28 teleconference on December 15, 2021 were approved.
- Change to the WG-28 Co-Chair: Donald Peck has retired and would like to transfer the role to another member closer to new emerging technologies. He will continue to participate on the Working Group as a member. Nick Bevins was unanimously nominated and accepted the position.

- Francisco spoke with Steve Nichols about CP-2107 and why it does not include a reject flag. He provided Steve's rationale and the group reviewed it.
 - **Action:** Francisco will take these edits back to Steve Nichols then submit a new CP to WG-06.
- **Action:** Shayna to email David Clunie for an editorial change – In Section C.8.7.4.1.4, Note #2, the figure reference C.8-2 link is incorrect, we believe it should point to C.8-10.

New Supplement on RDSR Informative Annex

- The group did a brief overview of Draft 4 of the Supplement to get a sense of where they are at and what needs to get done before the planned in-person meeting in September. Francisco and Nick provided an update of the changes they made since the last meeting.
 - **Action:** Shayna to send the Supplement to WG-22 leaders and invite them to the June teleconference so they can provide some dentistry examples.
 - **Action:** Nick to work with AAPM subject matter expert to help draft the Radio Fluoroscopy section before the June meeting.
 - **Action:** The group will continue to work on the Supplement in preparation for a two-day teleconference in June.
