1. Opening

- 1.1. Welcome and roll call: the teleconference was called to order and a quorum was present.
- 1.2. DICOM Antitrust and patent rules were reviewed.

2. Status requested: 2012-11-B Structured Report Model for Application Hosting

- 2.1. Shayna asked for a status update on an older Work Item: 2012-11-B, Structured Report Model for Application Hosting. David Clunie proposed this back in 2012 to do an abstract model for structured reports. The group asked about overlap with Supplement 219 and it was confirmed that 219 was written from a different work item (2019-04-D).
- 2.2. It seems the underlying issue of handing two host applications is no longer relevant, and having an XML-JSON style of coding was taken over by Sup219. Therefore, the group agreed that this Work Item should be withdrawn. Shayna will reach out to David to see if this is an acceptable path forward.
- 2.3. **Action:** Shayna to email David, then recommend to the DICOM Standard Committee that 2012-11-B be withdrawn.

3. Supplement 224: Service Discovery and Control (Brian Bialecki)

- 3.1 Brian reviewed items added to the draft supplement since our November teleconference. The main item was the addition of a security section.
- 3.2 He plans to present Sup224 to WG-06 in January 2022 in preparation for Public Comment.
