1 CALL TO ORDER AND REVIEW OF ANTI-TRUST RULES AND DICOM PATENT POLICY

The meeting was called to order. Staff reviewed the Guidelines for Conducting NEMA Meetings and record attendance.

5 **Conference-** DICOM will not be holding a conference. Asked if could do 2021. Brazil also wanted to do 2021. TBD- push back to 2022 or do 2 conferences next year.

Possibly move to Spring or other season. October is late for the DSC. One member commented that India is very hot in April-May. September could be okay. March, September, October. Feb or early March would be good. Late Feb, early March might be ideal.

6 **DICOM Website Update-can review.**

Carolyn to provide to this. Progress pages. Make sure menu structure at progress pages matches the site.

Issues: Talked about setting up a wrapper where Bjorn could put his edited comments. Don't think menus should change. Needs to have everything coming out of the box and a segment where comment is then put.

Action: Send to Bill. Rebuild menu navigation inside Bjoern's.

Suggest take link out of DICOM news-to FTP to make sure. News ribbon would be basically going away.

General comment-when look for some information. Info is always outdated.

Part to update:

Procedures. When a new Chair is elected. (completed)

New work item approved, DSC add to this. (already there, done)

Ad hoc- update WG-29. Email WG-29 for now, a few people look at it. One of the people with editing privileges will do it.

DICOM/Join- if want to join the DSC or the WG. Suggestion for join v. participate. Park: pick up again when website is final. Then add—keep as an idea.

Audience update. When first created the website, had the audience update. Who potential audience would be?

Action: Kevin can circulate audience info.

Current CPs: Point to David's page. (CH: New work items, add to agenda).
Supplements currently on David's site.

7. SIIM Tutorials- any updates: Do we want to do any targeted tutorials? TBD- Brad has done a demonstration of UPSRS on AI processing, has been done.

Do you have to pay for SIIM? Some are up. Part of the SIIM Conference-\$100. June 21 will be released.

Action: Ken and Kevin to follow up.

9. Tooling- we are updating.

GitHub- Jupiter notebook. Contains docker container that runs open source PACS using Orthonk. Using PiDICOM. Has another module using DICOM Web, using STOW, using query by patient, modality, etc. Use WADO to show how to retrieve and everything step by step. Right page would be GitHub. Someone can download and add updates, etc. DICOM doesn't have something like that. Could be another thing to set up.

Would be a great place to keep source code there. Right now, DICOM standard – the docbook is sitting on FTP site. Indexed from the site. Could replicate on GitHub.

We support putting it on GitHub. Larry would, or Brad could set up an org there. Does it make sense to curate this, too?

Action: Larry, Elliot, Rob, and Brad come up with a few proposal/writeup. One official DICOM distribution (Docbook of standard), and the other would be DICOM Community. Look at it as distribution, can talk about change management. Make the expectation clear in description of repository, make sure it's clear what the change process is. Make sure it's just Brad's demo-chose to use these tools. Have to get to how organize repository.

Split people expect: DICOM-repositories that you describe. Has multiple repositories around what do people want to clone as a unit.

Third category-presentations and tutorials. Need to avoid endorsement and have distinctions. Run past counsel (CH will do after the proposal writeup is ready).

Do we need a formal motion for this?

Look at GitLab and other alternatives.
