GE has developed an internal tool that can automate recovery of headings. GE is willing to run it periodically and will evaluate if source of the tool can be shared.
- Supplement 207 (All)- Revisit the material that was developed in 2018 and discuss again in WG-31. Request for a few concrete examples.
- Machine readable conformance statement- there is an existing work item in IHE. Would it be automatically extracted and would it be used? This possibly hasn't progressed because it hasn't had a champion. It would be a good start to look at the XML in Word version.

When have extraction of information from GE, if could become open source and then have that on the basis for machine readable. Template itself in Pt. 2 has been designed so that machine readability was taken into account. The group should to examine if this was actually the case.

Conclusion is to keep on the shelf and check back in two years. Currently no real champion for this but may evolve, also.
