CP-2270 went to Letter Ballot. Comments came back from WG-06 mtng back in August.

Looking at the change we proposed, we felt it made sense to move this reference to other sections of DICOMWeb.

The aim of this CP is to add parity to the CFIND changes and has nothing to do with inventory objects; therefore, did not implement changes to the NPI (non-patient instance) section of DICOMweb.

A number of comments focused on section 8.3.4.3

Action – follow up with WG-27, meeting the 3rd week of October, review with them before the WG-06 meeting in the first week of November.

- Ideas to evangelize Sup # 223:
 - Send an email to all WG members (most are vendors) and ask them if their company has been incorporating Sup223 and/or if they are hearing questions from their customers asking them for it
 - SIIM to host another webinar on Migrations – November 15
 - Host a WG meeting during RSNA – Room booked for 11/27 8-10 AM CT:
 - Need F&B
 - Invite list
 - Invite through Outlook
 - Agenda
 - Simple AV included (projector, screen)
 - Need Zoom option?
 - Discuss a possible Connectathon

Anna will create a Google form to ask 2 main questions to WG-33 members: 1) re: adoption of Supplement 223 by their companies, and 2) if they will be able to join the WG-33 mtng at RSNA 2023 on Nov 27. Keith and Matt to review and provide edits. Anna will send the form to all WG-33 Members on the list as the first round, followed by an actual RSVP for the Nov 27 meeting for planning purposes.

- Updated list of projects (**we will NOT pursue for now, focus on Sup # 223 evangelization**)
 - Update, Deprecate and Change Lock DIMSE and DICOMweb services for archive synchronization. Such services could also be useful for post-processing or research systems such as AI platforms, workstations, and applications containing temporary data stores. See for example [Microsoft](#), [Google](#) and [dcm4chee](#) delete extensions to DICOMweb.
 - Evaluate synergies between the Inventory Storage SOP class and the OHDSI OMOP common data model. WG-33 could develop use cases (such as the one described [here](#)) and identify synergies/gaps in the Research Use case described in Supplement 223.
 - Develop attributes, and possibly services, that facilitate the movement of selected studies/patients to different levels of tiered storage. See PS3.3 [C.4.23.1.1 Instance Availability](#).
 - **NEW:** Many PACS contain data such as scanned documents, tech notes or reports that, although stored with patient or exam/accession context, are not available through the DICOM Query/Retrieve interface. A useful enhancement of the inventory

function would provide links to these objects with available metadata.
