Rationale for Change:  The command-specific status codes are listed in PS 3.4 (e.g. on page 24 for the C-STORE command), but there is no reference that these codes are conveyed in messages that are described in PS 3.7. It is confusing that the column "Related Fields" states a tag, but not the one in which the Status Code (here called "Protocol Code") is returned.	
Sections of Document Affected:  Sections B.2.3, C.4.1.1.4, C.4.2.1.5, C.4.3.1.4 and Tables B.2-1, C.4-1, C.4-2, C.4-3 of PS 3.4	

Suggested Wording of Change:

1. Replace the text of Section B.2.3 by the following text:  
Table B.2-1 defines the specific status code values which might be returned in a C-STORE response. General status code values and fields related to status code values are defined in PS 3.7.
2. Replace the text of Section C.4.1.1.4 by the following text:  
Table C.4-1 defines the specific status code values which might be returned in a C-FIND response. General status code values and fields related to status code values are defined in PS 3.7.
3. Replace the text of Section C.4.2.1.5 by the following text:  
Table C.4-2 defines the specific status code values which might be returned in a C-MOVE response. General status code values and fields related to status code values are defined in PS 3.7.
4. Replace the text of Section C.4.3.1.4 by the following text:  
Table C.4-3 defines the specific status code values which might be returned in a C-GET response. General status code values and fields related to status code values are defined in PS 3.7.
5. Replace in Tables B.2-1 and C.4-1 the column headlines "Protocol Codes" by "Status Codes".
