Rationale for Correction:  In PS 3.5 DT is defined as CCYYMMDDHHMMSS.FFFFFFFF&ZZZZ. In the definition CC is defined as "Century", which (in my opinion) would make it necessary to encode the date of today as: 20970918..., because we live in the 20th century. Wrong or true?

Correction Wording:  Change "CCYY" to "YYYY", drop "CC=Century" from the explanation, and change definition to "YYYY=year".
