Log Summary: Clarify use of Equivalent Meaning of Concept Name for codes	
Name of Standard PS3.16 2018b	
Rationale for Correction:  Sup169 allows post-coordinated constructs (see below) to be associated with pre-coordinated codes that have equivalent semantics. WG12 was advised to use EV (121050, DCM, "Equivalent Meaning of Concept Name") for those entries.  Although that 121050 is used elsewhere in the Standard for elements with a Value Type of CODE, the definition seems to contradict that usage. That definition is revised below.
