<p>Rationale for Correction</p> <p>Anatomic Region Sequence (0008,2218) is used with only a single sequence item, and this is deliberate in order to allow for only a single code concisely describing the entire region examined.</p> <p>However, the list of codes provided in CID 4031 does not provide sufficient codes for those regions that consist of contiguous well-described anatomical region, such as might be used for say an MR examination of the entire thoraco-lumbar spine, or a projection radiograph of the entire body.</p> <p>After discussion with SNOMED, the following terms are deemed correct for inclusion in CID 4031.</p>
