<p>Rationale for Correction:</p> <p>CP 422 intended to implement the Issuer of Patient ID (0010,0021) attribute as part of a MPPS/GPPPS create/set messages. Tables F.7.2-1 and F.11.2-1 list the attributes allowed in the N-CREATE/N-SET messages.</p> <p>CP 422 added Issuer of Patient ID to the Performed Procedure Step Relationship Module and the General Purpose Performed Procedure Step Relationship Module, but not to the tables mentioned above. For the Performed Procedure Step Relationship Module and General Purpose Performed Procedure Step Relationship Module and there is no "All other attributes from ... 3/3" escape.</p> <p>Issuer of Patient ID needs to be explicitly mentioned in F.7.2-1 and F.11.2-1 to have them included in the PPS messages.</p>
