Log Summary: Sub Items limited to one for each SOP class in A-ASSOCIATE	
Type of Modification	Name of Standard
Clarification	PS 3.7 2008
Rationale for Correction: Clarify the allowed valid options for sub items in an A-ASSOCIATE request. Currently the Standard doesn't specify exactly how many role selection sub items may be present in an A-ASSOCIATE request. If more then 1 role selection sub item is present for the same SOP class it becomes unclear for the association-acceptor which sub item to use in the response. The Standard defines for SOP class extended negotiation sub item that only one for each SOP class UID is allowed, but doesn't specify that the A-ASSOCIATE request should contain abstract-syntax item with that SOP class. The Standard defines for SOP class common extended negotiation sub item that only one for each SOP class UID is allowed, but doesn't specify that the A-ASSOCIATE request should contain abstract-syntax item with that SOP class.

Correction Wording:

The SCP/SCU Role Selection Sub-Item shall be made of a sequence of mandatory fields. This Sub-Item is optional and if supported, one or more SCP/SCU Role Selection Sub-Items may be present in the User Data Item of the A-ASSOCIATE-RQ. **The Association-requester may only offer one SOP Class SCP/SCU Role Selection Sub-Item for each SOP Class UID or Meta SOP Class that is present in the A-ASSOCIATE request.** Table D.3-9 shows the sequence of the mandatory fields.

The Association-requester may only offer one SOP Class Extended Negotiation item for each SOP Class UID or Meta SOP Class **that is present in the A-ASSOCIATE request.**

The Association-requester may only offer one SOP Class Common Extended Negotiation item for each SOP Class UID or Meta SOP Class **that is present in the A-ASSOCIATE request.**
