Note

This implies that the pixel data within Icon Image Sequence (0088,0200) Items will be preserved.

The Waveform Data (5400,1010) attribute shall not be included within the Waveform Sequence (5400,0100).

Private Attributes may be preserved or discarded by a Storage SCP, as defined in Section B.4.1. A Storage SCP that claims conformance to Level 2 (Full) support of the Storage Service Class may choose to return Private Attributes in the2 Retrieve Without Bulk Data Service or not. Whether or not particular Private Attributes are returned shall be documented in the Conformance Statement.

Note: The decision as to whether or not to return a particular Private Attribute may be dependent on its size.
